

CLIMBING IS DANGEROUS.

Please follow these actions when
inside the Calgary Climbing Centre.



ROPED CLIMBING

Regardless of your level of experience, always check your partner before leaving the ground.

Facility belay checks are required for both top rope climbing and lead climbing and test a range of competencies we feel are important to climb in our facilities.

- Anyone can challenge the top rope check
 - Anyone 12 & up can challenge a lead check*
- *Both lead climbing and lead belaying skills MUST be demonstrated during a successful lead check*

Only belay with approved devices. For example:

- tube style belay devices such as a BD ATC
- geometry assisted-braking belay devices such as the Edelrid Jul or Mammut Smart
- mechanical assisted-braking belay devices such as the Petzl GRIGRI

Only Calgary Climbing Centre Instructors can teach belay related skills in our facility.

Do not walk, climb or sit under a climber or between a belayer and the wall.



BOULDERING

If bouldering in roped areas, please do not climb above the marked boulder line.

If bouldering in roped areas, do not boulder under a roped climber. In these areas, roped climbers are given the right of way.

Do not walk, climb or sit under a boulderer.



YOUTH SUPERVISION AND GUIDELINES*

Climbers 13 & under must be actively and closely supervised by an accompanying adult at all times. The Calgary Climbing Centre is not childproof.

If belaying, those 13 & under must be actively supervised by a belay checked adult (18+) who is on the ground beside them at all times.

Climbers 14 & older can climb and belay unsupervised.

Climbers 17 & under must use a mechanical assisted-braking belay device.
